General Information

What is MCS 140?

2025 marks the 140th anniversary of the founding of The Methodist Church in Singapore (MCS), also known as MCS 140. This milestone also coincides with SG60, celebrating 60 years of Singapore's independence.

How is Methodist Welfare Services (MWS) involved in MCS 140?

As the social concerns arm of MCS, Methodist Welfare Services (MWS) is leading the social outreach project for MCS 140. MWS also spearheaded similar initiatives during previous MCS anniversaries in 2010, 2015, and 2020. Our mandate is to engage and unite Methodists—working in partnership with Methodist churches—in acts of service and love for the less advantaged, demonstrating the social impact of the Methodist community.

What is the meaning behind “The Healing Nation”?

The theme of healing which brings about peace and security is found in Jeremiah 33:6: *“I will heal my people and let them enjoy abundant peace and security.” (NIV)*

The Methodist churches and social/community services share a common purpose, which is in the healing of relationships, heart, mind, soul and body:

- Methodist good works bring about healing in many forms - spiritual well-being, physical health, mental health, relationships and finances.
- People who experience healing will find peace and security as God has promised in Jeremiah 33:6.

What are the objectives of The Healing Nation?

- Provide a platform for Methodists to come together and invite friends and family for engagement with the church and organisations of good works.
- Galvanise Methodists to pledge 35 volunteer hours each (or a total of 1.4m hours) to serve the disadvantaged
- Raise \$1.4m for healing works amongst:
 - Families experiencing Distress, through restoring of familial/ marital/ parenting relationships, alleviating debt burdens and addressing mental health issues
 - those who are Chronically Sick and Homeless, by restoring dignity, improving quality of life and enhancing health outcomes
 - Youth and Children, including children with special needs, by addressing the impact of trauma, instilling hope and uplifting self-worth.
- There are 2 major initiatives in The Healing Nation:

- Healing Time - Pledge 1.4m volunteer hours with like-minded individuals or as a Methodist family
- Healing Soul - Raise \$1.4m through The Healing Nation Concert to bless up to 1,000 families and individuals

Healing Time – Pledge 35 Hours Each to Raise 1.4m Hours Together

Do I have to pledge 35 hours?

We hope that everyone can pledge 35 hours each to serve the community together.

How do I pledge?

Visit www.thehealingnation.sg to create an account. This gives you access to your profile page, where you can state your volunteering preferences, update your availability, sign up for opportunities, and track your volunteer hours.

Do I have to serve/actualize my pledged hours in 2025?

You can complete your pledged hours from 2025 till February 2027.

What are the volunteer opportunities available?

Our AI-powered platform connects you with personalised volunteer opportunities tailored to your interests, skills, and schedule. Based on your profile details, you'll be matched with volunteer opportunities posted by charity partners and Methodist churches.

In addition, our volunteer opportunities across race and religion serves to demonstrate our solidarity and mutual respect with other faith-based charities in supporting people in our community to further God's work through acts of services and love.

Can I volunteer as a group?

Yes, you can volunteer with your friends, family, or church members. Simply create an account with a group name and log in to select volunteer opportunities—just like an individual account.

Do I need to create a separate group account if I already have an individual account?

Yes, do sign up as a group with your group name and pledge the accumulative hours that your group intends to serve. For example, if there are 10 members in the group and every member in the group wishes to serve 3 hours, the total pledged hours will be $10 \times 3\text{hrs} = 30\text{hrs}$.

Do I need to have specific skills or experience to volunteer?

Experience and skills while useful are not necessary. Many opportunities are open to anyone with just the heart to serve. For roles that require specific skills or experience, they will be indicated.

How do I sign up for volunteer opportunities?

On creating your account, you will receive suggested volunteer opportunities matched to your preferences by Artificial Intelligence. New opportunities may be sent to your email weekly. It is crucial to complete your Profile so that the platform is able to better match you with volunteer opportunities that align with your interests and availability.

A QR code will be generated for you to scan and record your hours. Alternatively, you may log in the completed hours through your account by posting a review of your experience about the completed volunteer opportunity.

How will the donations be used?

- Families experiencing Distress, through restoring of familial/ marital/ parenting relationships, alleviating debt burdens and addressing mental health issues
- Those who are Chronically Sick and Homeless, by restoring dignity, improving quality of life and enhancing health outcomes
- Youth and Children, including children with special needs, by addressing the impact of trauma, instilling hope and uplifting self-worth

All donations raised will be channelled to participating charity partners and Methodist churches serving diverse causes and ministries.

Will I receive tax deduction for my donation?

Donations made through The Healing Nation are eligible for tax deduction under prevailing IRAS regulations as they will be collected by Methodist Welfare Services (MWS) which is an IPC (Institution of Public Character). Currently, the tax deduction rate is 2.5x of the donation amount.

Can I donate anonymously?

Yes, you may donate anonymously. Kindly note that you will not be entitled to tax deductions.
