## Messages from the Organiser: Methodist Welfare Services (MWS)



MWS is honoured to collaborate with The Methodist Church in Singapore (MCS) to produce The Healing Nation Celebratory Concert to commemorate its 140th Founding Year (MCS 140) and SG60.

In 2025, MWS launched two major initiatives to mark MCS140 and SG60, namely, to raise 1.4 million volunteer hours and \$1.4 million. Partnering with Methodist Churches, SG Cares Volunteer Centres under the Ministry of Culture, Community & Youth (MCCY), and leading digital platform, Give.Asia, we have reached out to 46,000 Methodists as well as the wider community to pledge hours to serve the community through more than 100 social service agencies. # Programme Overview

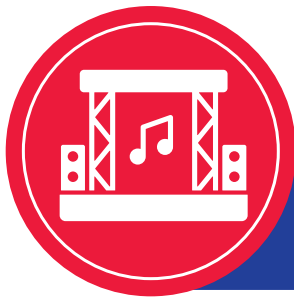

With soloists, choirs, dancers and performances by beneficiaries themselves, the concert paints a picture of what it means to love our neighbour and build a more compassionate Singapore.

This concert is part of The Healing Nation (THN) movement, launched to mark the 140th anniversary of The Methodist Church in Singapore. It honours a legacy of service that began in 1885 with the Church's first humble outreach efforts and continues today through the work of Methodist Welfare Services (MWS) and the wider Methodist community. Just as the early church sought to care for the poor, the sick and the vulnerable, this movement calls us to be agents of healing in today's world.

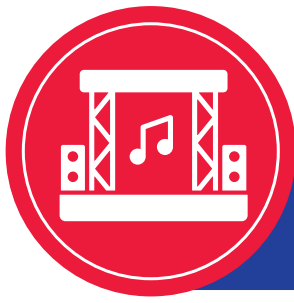
## 2 Combined Children's Choir

## 5 Dance Spectrum International



Dance Spectrum International (DSI) is a premier dance school in Singapore founded in 1995, led by Founder and Artistic Director, Ms Sharon Liew. She trained at The London College of Dance and at Buckingham University (UK) with a full scholarship from Lee Foundation, Shaw Foundation, and the National Arts Council.

Sharon is an active member of Wesley Methodist Church and is passionate about outreach and strongly committed to DSI's mission in giving back to the community. As part of community outreach, she formed a choir and ukulele interest group that is open and free to all her students. She has organised mission trips and brought teams from within DSI to Cambodia, Philippines, Korea, and most recently spent 5 weeks in Timor-Leste to support the St Paul's Methodist School's official opening service in 2025.

Sharon has also been working with children with special needs, in particular children and young adults with Autism & Down Syndrome for the past 22 years. DSI strongly believes in diversity and inclusion and has classes for individuals with special needs and has created the space and opportunity for them to learn and perform in public events and fund-raising concerts, including the Purple Parade, Special Olympics, Youth Olympics and with the Singapore Ballet.

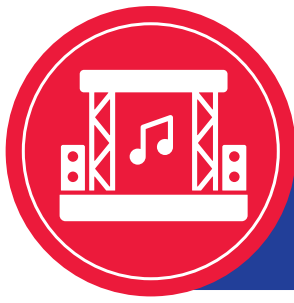

## 6 TRAC & ETAC Drum Ensemble



The Trinity Annual Conference (TRAC) & Emmanuel Tamil Annual Conference (ETAC) Drums Ensemble brings together 40 members from Wesley Methodist Church's Creative Expression Ministry (CEM) and Pasir Panjang Tamil Methodist Church. Led by Stephen Tan—CEM's founder and head—the group performs an energetic mix of Taiko, Surdo, Chinese drums, and assorted percussion, with Raymond Gabriel adding depth with his classical Indian Tabla. Stephen teaches the CEM members, with ages ranging from 20s to 70s, in various drumming techniques, while Raymond contributes over 30 years of Tabla expertise, blending styles into an engaging, up-beat musical presentation.

## 7 Soloist - Dr Kevin Ong



Dr. Kevin Ong is a dentist with a lifelong passion for music, whose journey has taken him from national competitions to international stages. He first made his mark with an acapella group in Singapore Broadcasting Corporation's (SBC) Talentime before signing with WEA Records as part of the gospel group "The Onesimus Principle". In the 1980s, he recorded three duets with Tracy Huang and contributed backup vocals for artists such as Tracy Huang and Alan Tam. He also presented the quiz show "Strategy" for the Reservists Association on SBC and proudly represented Singapore at the Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union Golden Kite Popular Song Contest in 1991. One of his most treasured experiences was performing "The Prayer" with his daughter, Nathania Ong, Singapore's West End star, at ChildAid 2010. Today alongside his musical pursuits, Dr. Ong continues his dental practice and finds joy in spending time with his beloved family.

## 8 Soloist - Lauren Yeo



Lauren Yeo is a 22-year-old soprano soloist from Singapore, described by Canadian producer David Foster as a vocalist with "charisma, confidence, and a sparkle in her eye". She has performed internationally in Southeast Asia, China, the UK, and New York City's Carnegie Hall. Lauren made history as the youngest Singaporean to win at the 70th Llangollen International Musical Eisteddfod in Wales, the same competition won by renowned singer Pavarotti in 1955. She sung with the MGS choir as a Secondary 1 student in 2016 and is excited to be singing with them again almost a decade later.

## 9 Passion Flag



Passion Flag was founded in 2019 by June Chiam, a Singapore-based flag maker, artist, and dancer. What began as a small business offering bespoke, hand-painted silk worship flags has grown to reach a global audience. Through her YouTube and social media channels, June shares worship flag dance videos and flag technique tutorials that inspire and equip people around the world.

The heart of Passion Flag is to make worship dance accessible to everyone, especially those without formal dance training. In 2024, Passion Flag expanded its mission by launching classes. This created more opportunities for worshippers. Since then, more than 120 individuals have been trained and equipped to express their faith through this artform.

## 10 MWS Active Ageing Centres



The Ukulele performers are from 2 MWS Active Ageing Centres (namely, Charis ACE - Geylang East and GreenTops@Sims Place). The group comprises staff, volunteers and senior beneficiaries who share a common passion for music. They meet at the Centres on a weekly basis to play and sing evergreen melodies that lift up spirits and warm their hearts. The group started jamming together 10 years ago and constantly welcomes new joiners. The seniors enjoy spreading love and joy to others through music and songs. Over the years, they have performed at various community places, private functions, and corporate events.

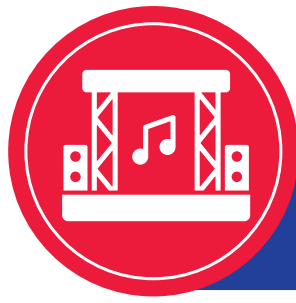
## 11 TRAC Seniors Ukulele Group

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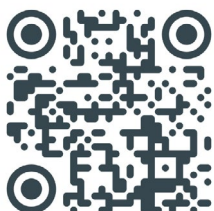
